S/0405/09/A Granta Garage' Linton by-pass – display sign (retrospective) - permission granted

S/0121/09/F Mr H Basra, 77 High Street – installation of a satellite dish (retrospective application)

  - The visual impact is minimal due to positioning on the flat roof and acceptable in this instance. However, the dish should be removed when no longer required, and this installation should not be considered a precedent for residential properties

Mr Bickerstaff, The Guildhall, 4 Church Lane – to reduce height of yew tree by 40% and shorten lateral branches to rebalance crown to facilitate light to greenhouse. This was noted.
