## Public Forum

## The Chairman opened the meeting of the Planning Committee at 7.30pm

- 1 Apologies for absence were received from Mrs S Parry.
- 2 Declarations of Interest. There were none.
- 3 Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2011. Cllr Linsdell proposed that the minutes be adopted as a true record of the meeting. The proposal was seconded by Cllr Hunt and agreed by the meeting.
- 4 Matters arising from the minutes of the meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2011. Under item 8, correspondence item 24, the Assistant to the Clerk advised that the proposed bollards at Church Cottage would match those outside the Guildhall.  
Under item 9, S/0884/10/F, the Assistant to the Clerk read out the draft letter to Barbara Clarke, SCDC Conservation Officer. This was approved and it was agreed that it should be sent. **Clerk**  
Under item 9, Review of Planning Services at SCDC, Cllr Bald reported that comments had been collated and sent. A meeting would be arranged with Steve Hampson of SCDC to discuss the issues.
- 5 The following SCDC planning applications were considered:  
S/0859/11 Mr and Mrs Negus, 52 Chalklands – front porch  
COMMENT
  - Council supports this application
  - Council would like it to be noted that no plans were available on the website and no dimensions were shown on the plans e-mailed on the day of the meeting  
S/0947/11 Pembroke College, Greenditch Farmhouse, Balsham Road – first floor extension to dwelling and single storey rear link extension between dwelling and outbuilding  
COMMENT
  - Council supports this application
  - Council highly commends the design as being a combination of traditional and 21<sup>st</sup> century designs that complement each other and should enhance this area
  - Council will be pleased to see work commencing.  
S/1055/11 Dr R Wadwhani, 108 High Street – projecting sign (to relocate an existing sign at the front of the building to the side above access gate)  
COMMENT
  - Council supports this application
  - Council considers this to be a much better position for the sign but stresses that all fixings must only be onto 108 High Street and not encroach upon the adjacent building
